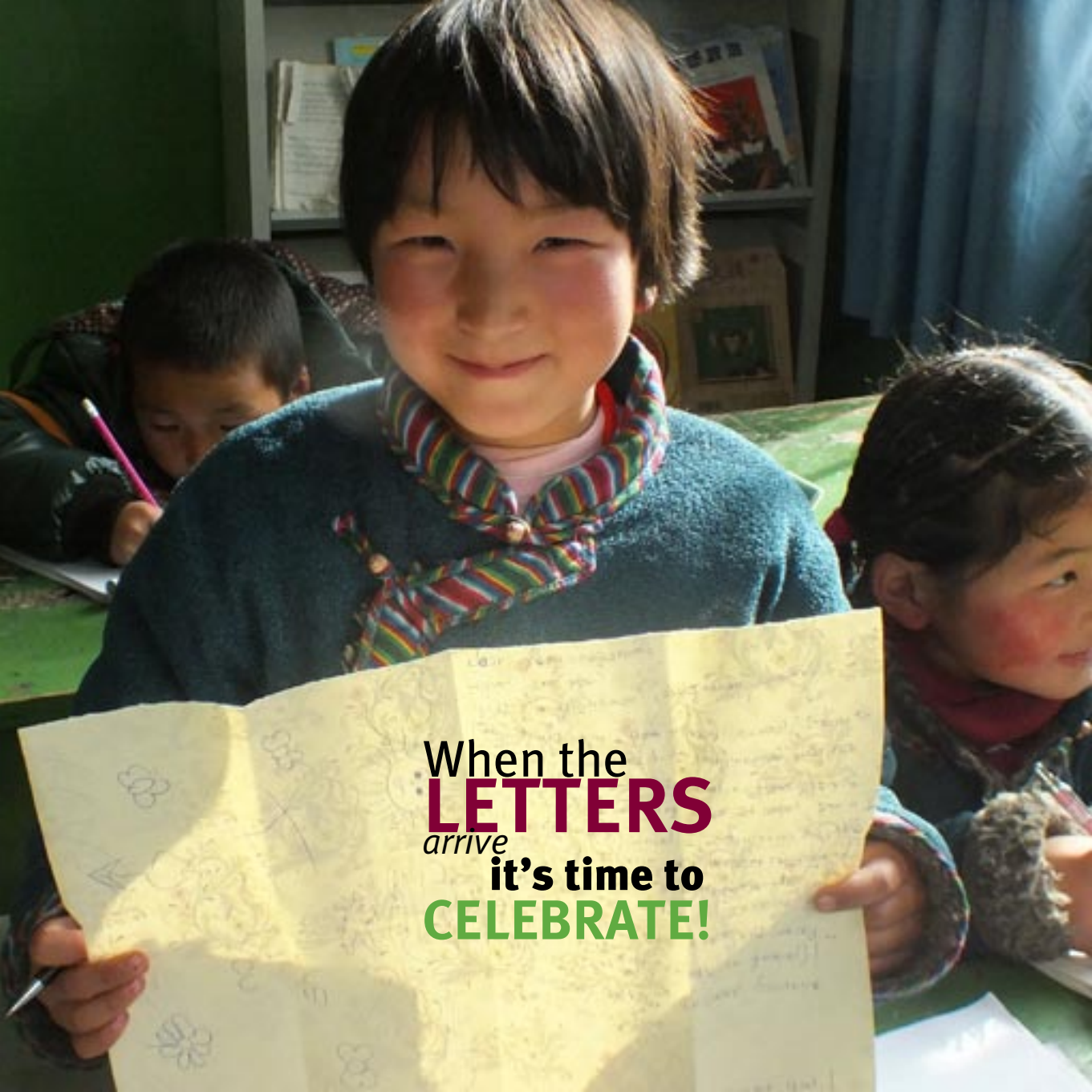




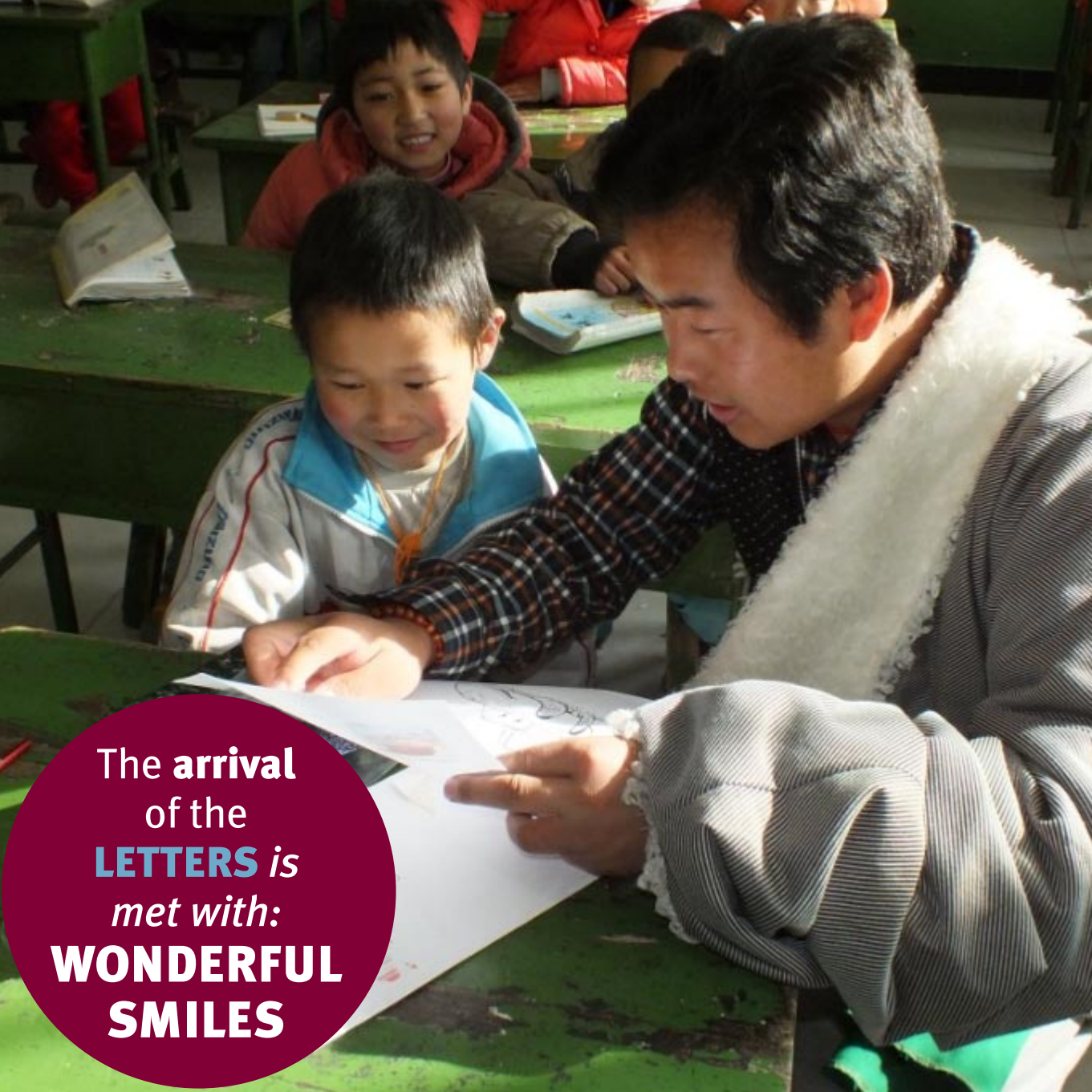

He speaks to them, takes their photos to send to their distance supporters and delivers letters. Bundles of letters!

Not all the children are good enough at English to read their letters on their own and, sometimes, they are even too young to read so Yangjeb sits with them and reads, translates, explains, describes and takes photos.
